Today's Plan:


Learning Target (standard): I will factor GCF's out of polynomial expressions.

Students will: Complete practice problems over previous concepts at the boards, put up homework problems on the board and make necessary corrections to their own work, take notes over new material and complete practice problems over new concepts.

GCF: $-2r^{2}$
