

## Today's Plan:

**Learning Target (standard):** I will evaluate piecewise functions and use correct function notation.

$$f(x) = -3x^2 + 2x - 4$$

$$\begin{aligned} a) f(0) &= -3(0)^2 + 2(0) - 4 \\ &= 0 + 0 - 4 \\ f(0) &= -4 \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} b) f(1) &= -3(1)^2 + 2(1) - 4 \\ &= -3 + 2 - 4 \\ f(1) &= -5 \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} c) f(-1) &= -3(-1)^2 + 2(-1) - 4 \\ &= -3 - 2 - 4 \\ f(-1) &= -9 \end{aligned}$$

$$f(x) = -3x^2 + 2x - 4$$

$$\begin{aligned} d) f(-x) &= -3(-x)^2 + 2(-x) - 4 \\ f(-x) &= -3x^2 - 2x - 4 \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} e) -f(x) &= -(-3x^2 + 2x - 4) \\ -f(x) &= 3x^2 - 2x + 4 \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} f) f(x+1) &= -3(x+1)^2 + 2(x+1) - 4 \\ &= -3(x^2 + 2x + 1) + 2x + 2 - 4 \\ &= -3x^2 - 6x - 3 + 2x + 2 - 4 \end{aligned}$$

$$f(x+1) = -3x^2 - 4x - 5$$



$$F(x) = \frac{x-2}{x^3 + x}$$

$$D: \{x | x \neq 0\}$$

$$x^3 + x = 0$$

$$x(x^2 + 1) = 0$$

$$x = 0$$

$$x^2 + 1 = 0$$


$$x^2 = -1$$

$$h(x) = \sqrt{3x - 12}$$

$$3x - 12 \geq 0$$

$$D: \{x | x \geq 4\}$$

$$\begin{aligned} 3x &\geq 12 \\ x &\geq 4 \end{aligned}$$



$$D: \{x | x < 0, x \geq 2\}$$

$$R: \{y | y \leq -3, 5 \leq y \leq 7\}$$

Find the domain.

$$f(x) = \frac{3-x}{x^2 - 4x - 12}$$

$$\begin{aligned} x^2 - 4x - 12 &= 0 \\ (x-6)(x+2) &= 0 \end{aligned}$$


$$x = -2, 6$$

$$D: \{x | x \neq -2, 6\}$$

Find the domain.

$$f(x) = \sqrt{x^2 - 3x - 10}$$

$$\begin{aligned}x^2 - 3x - 10 &\geq 0 \\(x-5)(x+2) &\geq 0\end{aligned}$$




$$\text{D: } \{x \mid x \leq -2, x \geq 5\}$$

Find the domain.

$$f(x) = \frac{2x+1}{\sqrt{x^2 + 4x - 12}}$$

$$\begin{aligned}x^2 + 4x - 12 &> 0 \\(x+6)(x-2) &> 0\end{aligned}$$



$$\text{D: } \{x \mid x < -6, x > 2\}$$

Given the functions, find the composite functions:

$$f(x) = -x^2 - 3x + 1$$

$$g(x) = 2 - x$$

$$f \circ g = f(g(x))$$

$$f \circ g = -(2-x)^2 - 3(2-x) + 1$$

$$= -(4-4x+x^2) - (6+3x+1)$$

$$= -4+4x-x^2-6-3x-1$$

$$f \circ g = -x^2 + 7x - 9$$
